

Welcome

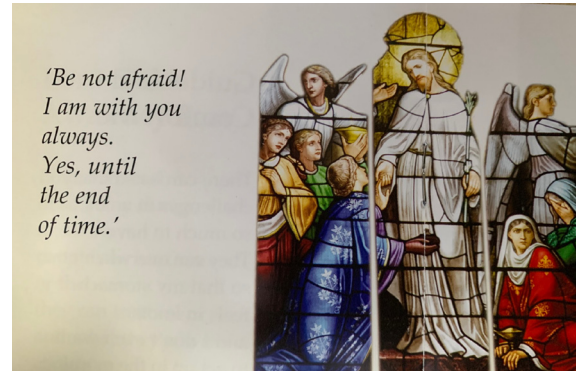




Coronavirus Prevention

It can be accessed by pupils from College or at home and allows them to browse the Library catalogue, reserve books, write reviews, create lists and bibliographies and much, much more.

To access from College, pupils need to click on the link in the Library folder from the Start menu and to access from home, pupils need to log onto Office 365 and click on the link from the App launcher. How to Borrow a Library Book

Click and Deliver



Unfortunately, pupils are not able to browse books on the shelves at the moment but they can still borrow a book from our Library. We are launching a new Click and Deliver service!

Complete a questionnaire

Pupils have all received an email to their College accounts with a link to a Click and Deliver form. Pupils can give the title of a book they would like to read OR answer the questions about the type of book they like (or don't like!) and Mrs Poolton will choose a book for them. All they have to do is click Submit!

You can personal library book service

Unfortunately, you can't browse the shelves in the library and choose your own books at the moment, so we are offering you a new way of borrowing books. Answer the questions below and Mrs Poolton will choose a book to send to your form room.

OR

Use our Online Library Catalogue



This allows pupils to browse the books on the "virtual" shelves of our Library and find a book they might like to read.

Our new online catalogue is called Accessit and it can be accessed in College or at home through Office 365. They will be able to have a look at the resources we have in the Library, search for a book or drag and drop any book cover into their own "Reserves" list.

Whichever way pupils choose to use the service, they can just sit back and wait for the book or books they have asked for to be delivered to their form rooms. They will arrive in a labelled paper bag and the date they are due back will be stamped on the label inside.

Don't worry - any books that have been used by someone else will have been quarantined for 72 hours
